

Toddler Time!: How to Make a Pigeon and School Bus Snack

Ingredients

- Graham crackers
- Cream cheese
- Food coloring (yellow & blue)
- Mini Oreo cookies
- Mini Nilla wafers cookies
- Golden Graham cereal (any square cereal will work)
- Mini chocolate chips
- Starburst candy (yellow)



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Instructions

- In two separate bowls, mix in the yellow food coloring with the cream cheese for the bus and blue food coloring for the pigeon's head (you will definitely need more for the bus than you need for the pigeon).
- Spread a thin layer of yellow cream cheese on the graham cracker.



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Instructions

- Take some Golden Graham cereal and place them on the graham cracker to make the windows for the bus.
- Next, split a mini Oreo cookie and place them onto the graham cracker for the wheels.
- For the pigeon's head, spread blue cream cheese on the flat side of the mini Nilla wafers and place onto the graham cracker.



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Instructions

- For the eye, take a mini chocolate chip and dab a little white cream cheese on the pointed part and place it on the Nilla wafer.
- Finally, take a yellow Starburst and soften it in the microwave for about 10 seconds. Tear a little piece off and mold it into a beak for the pigeon and place it on the Nilla wafer.
