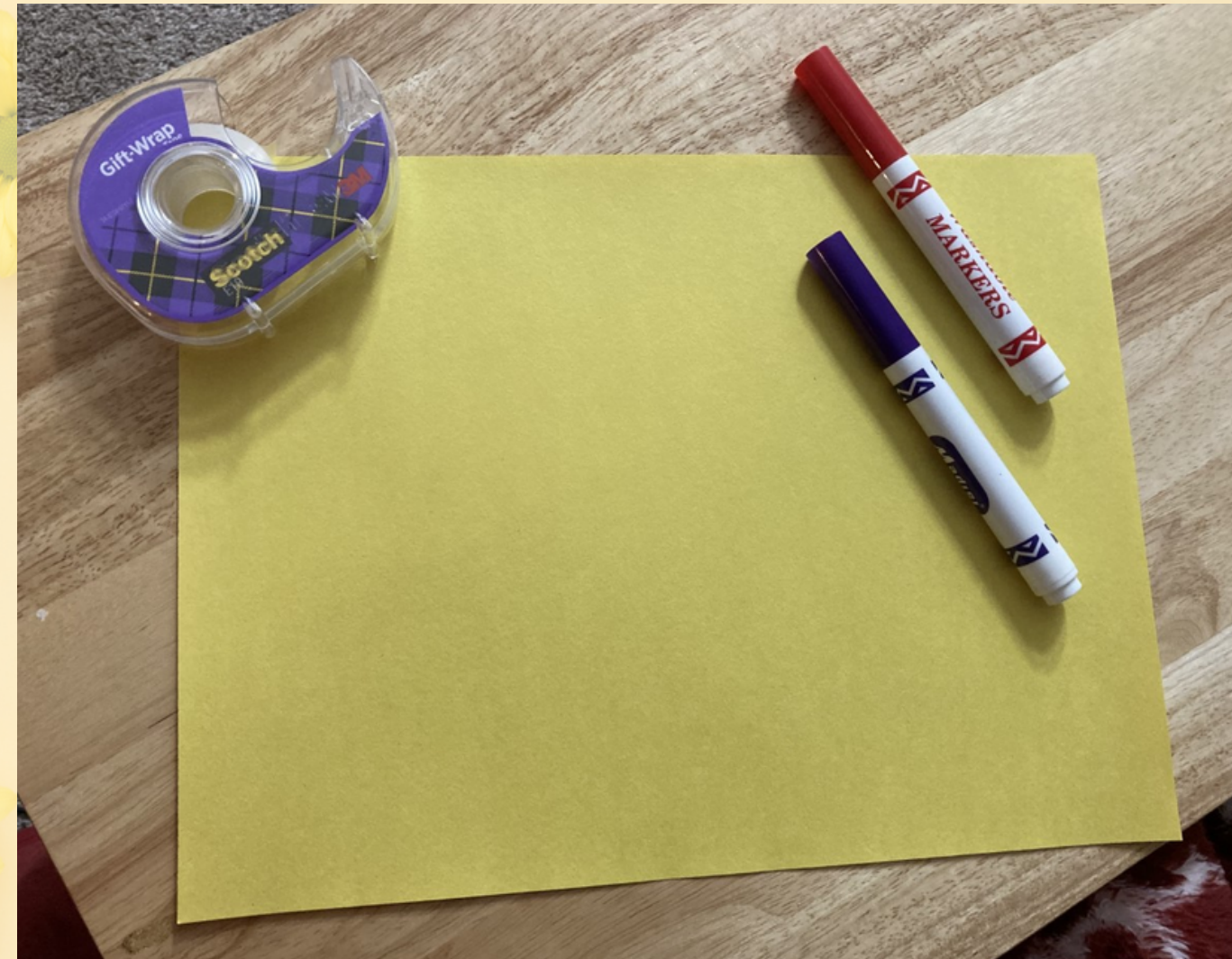


# Toddler Time!: How to Make a Paper Party Horn

## Supplies

- **Craft paper**
- **Tape**
- **Ribbons/Tinsel**  
**(optional)**
- **Markers/Bingo**  
**Dotters/Stickers**





## Instructions

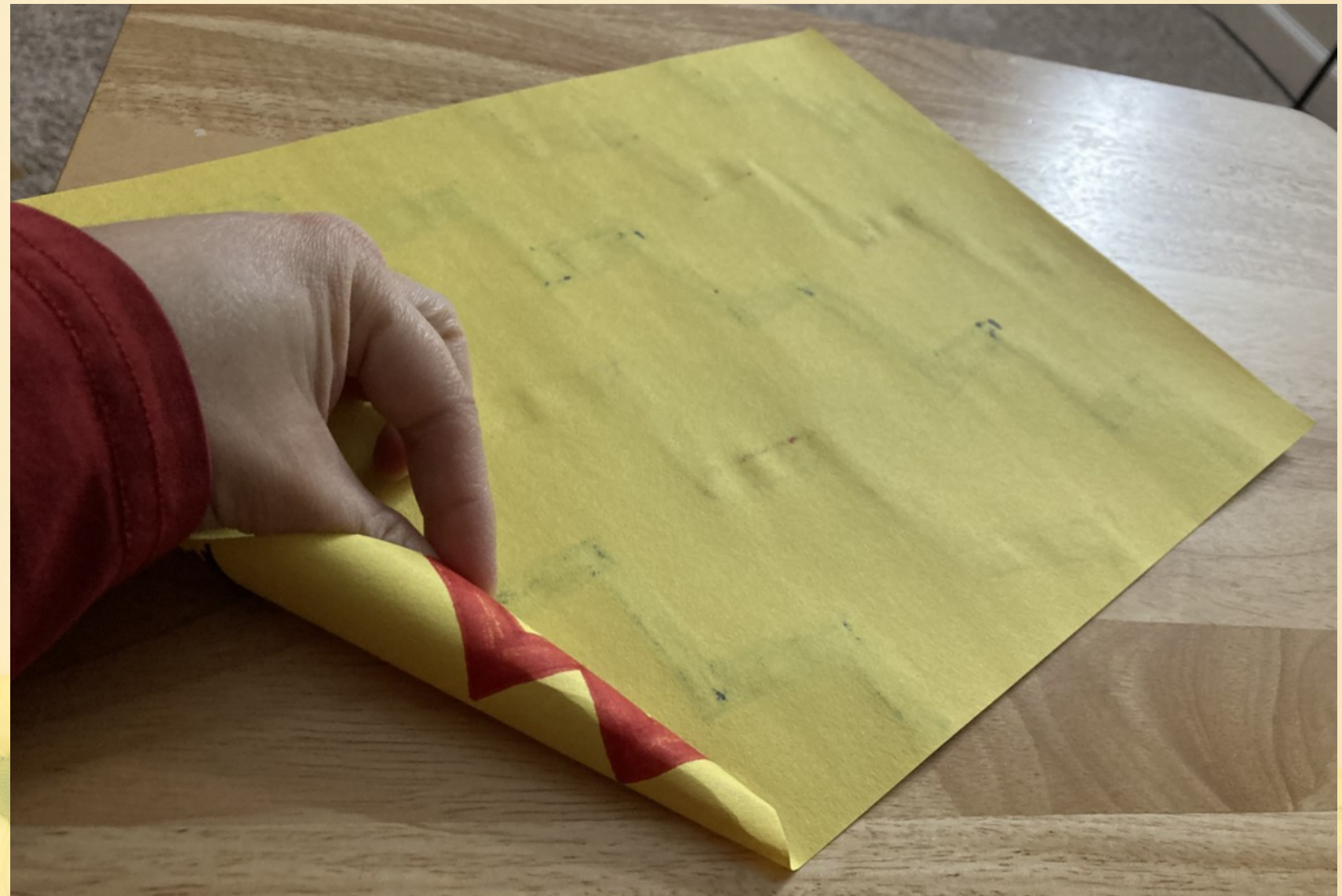
- **Decorate craft paper and tape ribbons to the paper.**





## Instructions

- **Start with one corner and roll the paper at an angle to make a cone with a small opening on one end to blow into and a larger opening at the other end for the fun noise to come out of.**






## Instructions

- **Secure the paper with tape on the side of the horn, then tape the small end of the horn to protect the paper from spit.**
