



You will need these Items to Make a Bracelet



Yarn or String

Beads of any kind

Scissors

A Ruler

• Unravel the string to a long amount.




• Wrap the string around your wrist.




• Pinch the string with your fingers where the end of the string meets the string that's wrapped around your wrist.



• Place the string onto a table with your finger remaining on the part of the string that the end touched.



- **Place** the ruler next to the string you have laid out.
- Take note of how long the measurement is. You may also mark this with a pen if you'd like! <u>8 inches, WOW!</u>



• Cut the string 1 inch past where you marked the string, <u>9 inches for me!</u>



 Now that you have your string cut, add some beads to the string using the holes on the beads!



- Tie the ends of the Beaded String.
- Enjoy your custom bracelet!
