

GUIDE LINES


- Participants must be in middle or high school for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Books and activities must be completed between June 6 and August 6, 2022.
- One book or activity per square.
- Books must be at least 100 pages long.
- Some activities require you to access the Eagle
 Public Library's Digital Collection. Go to the
 "Digital Library" tab at eaglepubliclibrary.org/ to
 find out how to access these resources. Libby,
 Hoopla, and Kanopy also have mobile apps. You will
 need your library card number to log in.
- Substitute any square for attending a Teen Class at the Eagle Public Library.

HOW TO PLAY

- Complete a line of BINGO to earn a prize. Repeat until your BINGO card is fully completed.
- Turn in a fully completed BINGO card to enter the Grand Prize Drawing.
- Get a new BINGO card to keep reading and keep earning prizes.
- For every complete BINGO card you turn in, you get another entry into the Grand Prize Drawing.
